After 10 years of private practice in the United States, he returned to South Africa to serve as Dean of the University of Transkei Medical School and subsequently as Vice President at the University of Cape Town. His publications have encompassed obstetrics and gynaecology, public health, medical education and medical publishing in developing countries. Dr Ncayiyana is consultant to the WHO and the World Bank.
